Amazing News from Myanmar— More than 1,800 civilians have died during the ongoing military coup and more than 13,000 have been arrested. They continue to go from village to village burning homes. Over 800,000 people have been displaced within the country and over one million refugees have fled the country to neighboring countries of India, Thailand and Bangladesh.

However, as Joseph declared in Genesis 50:20 ***But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save much people alive.*** In the midst of all these catastrophes, Christ is still being proclaimed, people are getting saved, following the Lord in baptism and churches are being started. The three churches below are being started by IBOM Church Planters Boyling, Yaw Nway and Kongtoi. In foreign lands, especially places under persecution, it is not unusual to see churches gathering and started under a big tree. We are so thankful for the humility accompanied with determination of the Burmese people.

South Korea— Preparations are under way for “**Operation 250**” in August as we partner with Bro. Daniel, Bro. Silas, the Bible Team and Hope Baptist Church to distribute 250,000 pieces of literature among North Korean refugees. We also desire to raise the funds for 1000 data chips to carry the light of the Gospel into North Korea. We need \$4300 for the data chips. Airline tickets, hotels, meals and miscellaneous expenses will cost an additional \$6000.
