Dear Co-Laborers in the Gospel,

We want to begin this letter with a sincere expression of **our appreciation to all of you for your prayers for us**. The apostle Paul told the Philippian believers to "be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God." You have done this in our behalf, and we will be forever grateful.

In our last letter, we made reference to neighbors who are even more open to discussing the Gospel since Frank's stroke and surgeries. The Lord continues to open doors, and we are excited about what He is doing. Recently we got some new neighbors across from us. **Daniel and Diana are a young Ukrainian couple**, and we have reached out to them in several ways and given them a gospel tract. I also had the privilege of sharing the gospel with **Teresa's boyfriend next door**, and he was very open.

The Lord has opened the door for us to once again reach out to Hispanics. **We have had some great contacts with a number of Hispanics**, and they have received the tracts joyfully. One lady, who was working at the time, held the tract up and said in Spanish, "I will read it." We have also had contact with Carlos but have to wait because he is planning to move. Along this line, we have been in touch with our former Spanish students and are encouraged about the possibility of teaching Spanish again if the Lord wills.

We have everything prepared to embark on our church's **"Pray and Go" ministry** this week. Today we went to the area that we did previously to visit a lady with whom we had talked and prayed about a year ago. She is a believer, and our time with her was an encouragement to us all. This ministry involves praying, leaving door hangers and prayer follow up. Please pray for those who will be visited through this ministry and that the Lord will open opportunities to share the Gospel.

We mentioned in our last letter that Frank was scheduled for **two cataract surgeries**. The surgeries also involved inserting a small stent in both eyes, and the process went very well. At the end of May he is scheduled for a checkup and will then be able to get new reading glasses. Also, he was given a nuclear stress test to make sure that there were no other blockages, and everything was fine.

Having seen so much progress in Frank's recovery, Pastor Tony Seiber, who is our senior adult S.S. teacher, has asked Frank to teach for two Sundays in June (5 & 12). This a great opportunity but I need your prayers.

We want to share that **we now have 8 great-grandchildren**. Our grandson, Jonathan and Hope are the proud parents of **Ellianna Faith** and Seth and Jessica are the proud parents of **Everly Rose**. Also, Jonathan loves his job at Wal-Mart and Hope has chosen to work from home so that she can be with their baby.

Thank you very much for praying for us and for those of you who support our ministry. Please pray for us that we will be a constant witness to our neighbors, for open doors to reach Hispanics, our "Pray & Go" outreach, Bible study with Carlos, **teaching of our adult S.S. class** and for God's leading with regard to teaching Spanish again.
