The building is complete on the inside except for five doors that came today and will be installed next week. We are painting the outside one last time. The walk in cooler and freezer have been installed. I have two HVAC men that are installing all the cooling compressors. Sidewalks are in, carpet and vinyl are installed, and bathroom fixtures are installed. I am waiting on the tile man to come back and grout everything and put the tile on the walls of the kitchen. Most of the lighting is installed. We had Mixson's Auto Body paint some of the lights because of Covid you could not find all the fixtures in black. Thank you so much Mixson's Auto Body.

I am in the process of purchasing all the furniture for the building. I have purchased a 20' table for the men to eat at and for their daily studies. An Individual paid for the table. The bunk beds should be here any day. Blinds arrived a few days ago so we have to put them in. I am still looking for a commercial stove, refrigerator, and freezer for the kitchen. I also have to purchase living room suites for the main hall.

A Wonderful Church sent us a very large amount of money to help us with finishing this project. This church wants to remain anonymous. They have helped again and again with this project.

We will soon start on landscaping, planting oaks down the drive and cedar trees as a barrier between our property and the row of houses by our property.

If anyone knows of a cargo van, we are in need of one. We have a 2000 GMC Van that has about 300,000 miles on it and are needing to replace it with something newer and in better shape. We use this van for picking up donations, hauling things for the home and also pulling our different size trailers.

I want to thank each of you for all you have done for us at Fair Haven Home for Men, Inc. Your giving and praying is not in vain. Robbie wrote this week and said that he had been two years sober. His family is back together and serving our Lord. I have so many stories of men's lives transformed. I wish I had time to tell them all.
