I hope this letter finds everyone doing well today. We are now moved into the new building. The dedication service went very well. We had about 250 people here for that event. It was two weeks after that that we moved into the building due to getting our Certificate of Occupancy. The building is so nice, and it is serving a great purpose. Everything is in one location. We are still working through schedules on cleaning, choirs, and cooking. The building is complete except for a PA system, security cameras, a suppression system for the hood over the stove, and the culvert and paving for the driveway entrance coming in the front. We will get each one of these done in the near future.

We presently have Robert from SC, Cody from NC, Jonathan B. from SC, Thomas from SC, and Michael from SC. Cameron graduated from our first program last Sunday and is now working a job and has entered the second program. Chris and Jonathan W. are still here and working daily in our second program also.

These men are doing well. We are thankful for each one of them. I have Jonathan B. in a class to help him with his reading skills, I have Robert in a class to help him get his drivers license back. We have had a new opportunity with medical and dental care. An organization that we have helped in the past is now helping us with medical and dental needs for the men. Of course these are minor issues that the men need, but a great blessing when a man comes in they can be taken care of.

Bible Baptist Church in Waynesville, NC helped with the reading classes and the class for drivers license. I hired a teacher to come in and do reading classes three days a week for two hours.

As you know my cook Jimmy Rispoli passed away last year, and I have a need for a cook. Well, God sent Jonathan B. to us about a month ago. He is an excellent cook. He and Michael have been filling in until we can find a full time cook. Bro. Lance Neal is helping with a lot of the cooking, and that is a great help. We are still working through cooking schedules and food schedules. As all of you know the price of groceries has gone through the ceiling. It has affected us greatly.

Please continue to pray about the van for the home. I am looking for a cargo van for the home. We use it daily to haul stuff for the store, pick up donations and do general work. Our van is just worn out. What we have is a 2000 GMC Cargo van with over 300,000 miles and running on it's last leg.

Thank you again for all you do to help Fair Haven Home for Men, Inc. It is because of your prayers and financial support that we can help men struggling with addictions. We have seen men's lives changed. It makes it worth it all.
